What is Teens In Action (TIA)?

TIA is a dynamic, interactive leadership program designed to help high school students learn valuable Social and Emotional Learning (SEL) skills needed to successfully navigate from teen into adulthood!

From August through May, TIA students will engage in a SEL Bootcamp, monthly training workshops, and weekly volunteer projects with local Bay Area partner non-profits. These methods of delivery provide students with knowledge, skills, and experience to prepare them for life after high school.

How Do I Join?

Apply online for a slot during the 2015-2016 program year. Students are selected based on application content, interview feedback, recommendations, and date of submission. All parties will be notified by March 31, 2015.

How much does it cost?

A \$350 program fee applies for Service Learning Boot Camp, materials, snacks, shirt, and graduation. Scholarships may be available.
