



What is Teens In Action?

Teens In Action is an interactive leadership program designed to help high school students learn valuable Social and Emotional Learning (SEL) competencies needed to successfully navigate from teen to adulthood! From August through May, TIA students will engage in a SEL Bootcamp, monthly training workshops, and weekly volunteer projects with local Bay area partner non-profits.

These methods of delivery provide students with knowledge, skills, and experience to prepare them for life after high school.

How Do I Join?

Each year, applications for Teens In Action will open in January. Students are selected based on content, interview feedback, recommendations, and date of submission.

How Much Does it Cost?

A program fee of \$350* applies for the overnight Service Learning Bootcamp, 10 workshops, materials, snacks, T-Shirts, and graduation.
